- **Governing Board Members' Update**

Eastland-Fairfield Career & Technical Schools:

Mrs. Galbraith distributed a document to board members that provides a comprehensive list of the programs offered by EFCTS.

Delaware Area Career Center:

Mr. Bischoff reported that the DVD entitled, Transformation: Redefining Public Education for the 21st Century, was viewed by DACC board members at their last meeting. Copies of the DVD were provided to the ESCCO board members.

Metropolitan Educational Council:

No items to report.

- **Superintendent's Update**

Dr. Anderson shared a letter from Mr. Mark Ryan, New Albany-Plain Local Schools Board President, thanking the ESC of Central Ohio for their assistance during their Superintendent search process and for providing Dr. Bill Reimer to serve as Interim Superintendent.

Dr. Anderson informed board members that the ESC of Central Ohio is co-sponsoring, along with Kids.Ohio.org and the Columbus Urban League, a briefing on Ohio's proposed State Education Budget and related Policy changes. Dr. Robert Sommers, Director of the Governor's new Office of 21st Century Education will provide this briefing on March 21, 2011 at the ESCCO. The Superintendents, Treasurers, Board Presidents, and Teacher Association Presidents in our service area have been invited to attend.

Dr. Anderson announced that Jim Petro, former Ohio Attorney General, has been named the new Chancellor of Higher Education by Governor Kasich.

Dr. Anderson reported that the Columbus Academy of Literacy and Mathematics community school has been declared insolvent by their Treasurer. The ESC of Central Ohio stepped in and took control of the school on February 11, 2011 and recommended its closure. The school closed effective February 18, 2011 as a result of lack of enrollment to support the school financially.

Dr. Anderson informed board members that the ESCCO is working in conjunction with the Thomas B. Fordham Institute and five other school districts, to develop a state-wide authorizer group for community school sponsorship. Dr. Anderson also informed board members that the community schools sponsored by the ESCCO are the highest rated in the State of Ohio.

Dr. Anderson also reported that the ESCCO recently received a \$50,000 grant from The Columbus Foundation to fund the inter-district transportation study.

Dr. Anderson informed board members that amendments to Senate Bill 5 that would eliminate collective bargaining are due today. These amendments are expected to soften some provisions of the bill, but it is still expected that seniority layoffs will be eliminated if passed.

Dr. Anderson is expecting that there will be a 10% to 12.5% budget cut in education in the Governor's budget.
