Mr. Hutchinson reported that the transition to Optimal Health Initiatives (OHI) for services is almost complete.

- **Treasurer's Update**

Mr. Hutchinson reported to Board members that the ESC of Central Ohio Fiscal Year 2013 audit is complete with 2 minor citations.

Mr. Hutchinson informed Board members that Mr. Scott Gooding resigned from his Council of Governments position as Director of Fiscal Services to take the position of Budget Director with Columbus City Schools. The ESCCOG has hired Tammy Rizzo, the current Treasurer at Grandview Heights City Schools, to fill this vacancy. The ESC of Central Ohio will be conducting the search for a new Treasurer at Grandview Heights.

In response to a request by Board members for additional financial information, Mr. Hutchinson presented a sample report in a new format for their review.

- **Superintendent's Update**

Dr. Goodney began discussions on a list of proposed 2014-15 agency objectives distributed to Board members for their review. Dr. Goodney shared the Instructional Technology Audit Report 2013-14 prepared for Upper Arlington City Schools by Megan Ash, Coordinator of Digital Learning & Training, and Dale McVey, Client Services Representative. The ESC of Central Ohio will lead efforts to implement the report's recommendations.

Dr. Goodney distributed copies of an email from Hannah Powell, Executive Director of KIPP Columbus regarding how much the school values and appreciates Alan Hutchinson's leadership as their Treasurer. KIPP Columbus just received an Auditor of State Award for a clean audit and excellent financial practices.
