### 3.01 Board Work Session Items

1. Mr. Henry provided the Governing Board members with an overview of the work of the Ohio Center for Autism and Low Incidence. The presentation included the mission, vision, and structure of the agency; consulting services and the development of recommendations for the Governor's Office, Ohio Department of Development Disabilities and the Ohio Department of Education; and research, development and deployment of best practices and training state-wide. Mr. Henry also reported that this year's conference, OCALICON, included over 300 sessions for 1,400 participants from over 35 states.

2. Dr. Reed provided the Governing Board members with an overview of the responsibilities of the State Support Team – Region 11 including the Ohio Network for Education Transformation (ONET) - early college readiness, career readiness and global education; No Child Left Behind; work with low performing schools across the State (development of school improvement plans); special education improvement, special education compliance, and early childhood education support services.
3. Dr. Anderson updated the Governing Board members regarding State and Federal policy priorities for the upcoming year including school funding, HB 555 accountability and college/career readiness, workforce development, digital learning and school choice, improved teacher and principal quality, improved early childhood education, affordable/attainable college education and Medicaid reimbursement programs.

Dr. Anderson shared the ESC of Central Ohio's stakeholder report which illustrates how our work aligns with State and Federal policy priorities.

4. Dr. Anderson provided the Governing Board members with an overview on the work of Columbus 2020, the state of the Central Ohio Compact and the Pathways to Prosperity Network.
