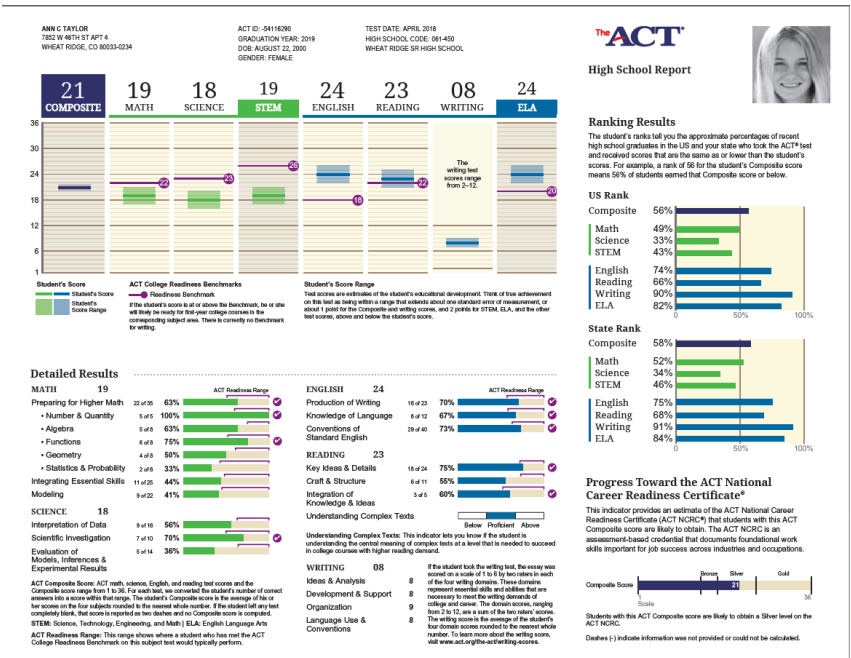

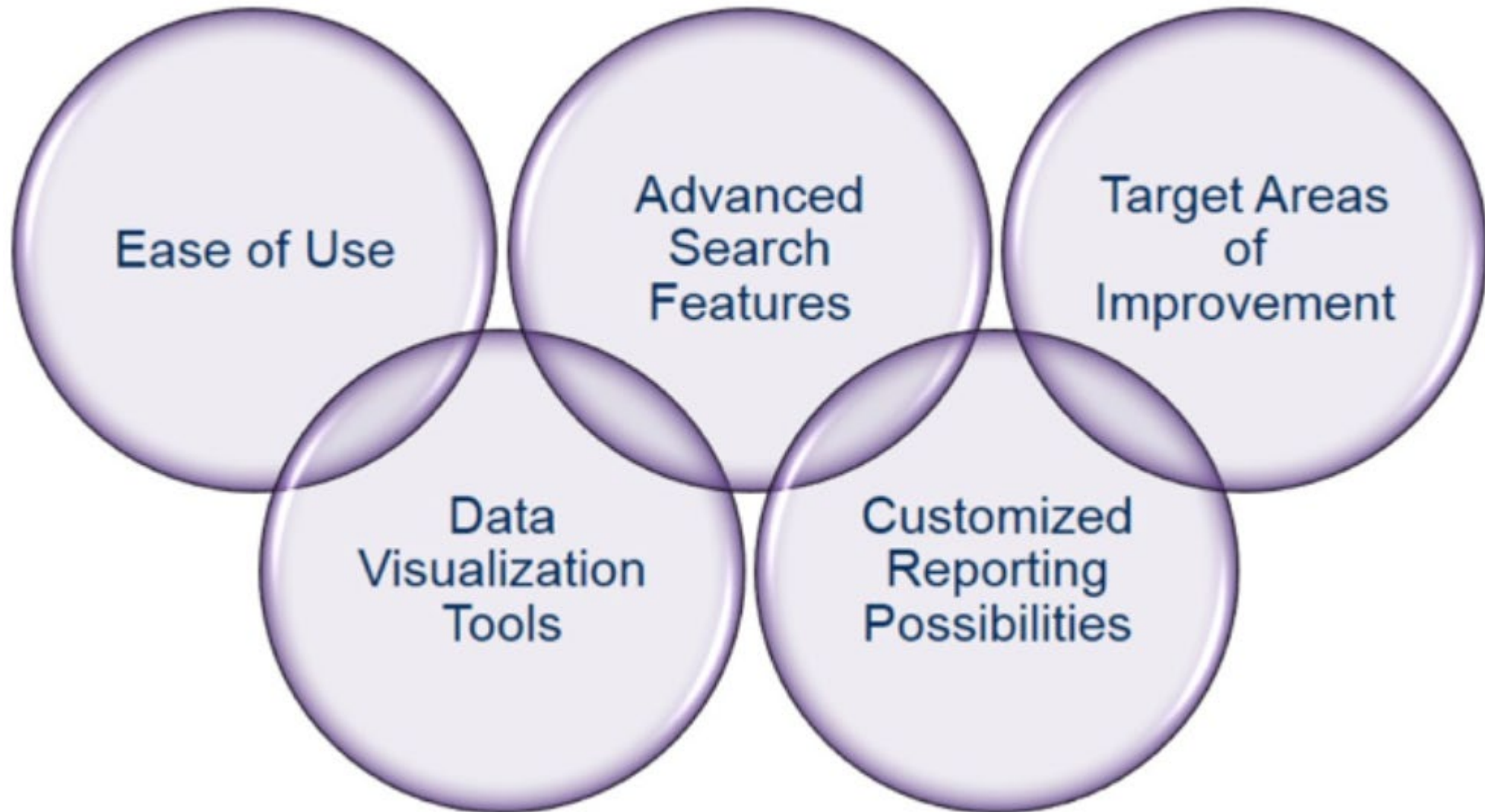

I am contacting you regarding ACT's Online Reporting System. You will find an attached letter that provides an overview of the online reporting tool that was launched last fall. This communication includes an access code specifically for **XXXXXXXXX Local School District**.

As Superintendent, you are automatically considered the primary Trusted Agent. As such, our Legal Department requires that the district access code be sent directly to you; however, you may forward the information to another staff member who can complete the verification and initial setup. It is not uncommon that the Trusted Agent access level also be assigned to other staff that you feel should have full access. The attached **User Guide** will outline the levels of access that staff members can be assigned.

To begin that process, either you or your designate would log into [success.act.org](https://success.act.org). The [success.act.org](https://success.act.org) site provides viewing and data reporting tools as well as TAA access (*Test Accessibility and Accommodations*). When the district account is created, it is important to check the box that indicates I **have an access code**. Be sure to type the District Name and Access Code exactly as listed on the attached letter. Step by step instructions can be found in the user guide if needed.
