Family Income Form – Title I eligibility verification

School-Parent Compact-each Title I school is to develop jointly with parent input

Schoolwide Plan Review - each Title I building - CCIP Completion of the SW components

Annual Evaluation of the Schoolwide school – evidence of the annual evaluation

Staff and Parent Surveys - each TA or SW served building for needs assessment evidence Inclusion of Special Education/Limited English Proficient/nonpublic data in the needs assessment Completion of SI components -evidence provided for access to the school's data & qualifications Supporting Effective Instruction - Title II-A - Inclusion of teacher input in the needs assessment Review District Professional Development Plan - use of teacher/administrator, community inputinclusive of what is indicated on the Title II-A Details page
