## ODJFS, the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council - OSAC and ApprenticeOhio

- The U.S. Department of Labor awarded "State Apprenticeship Agency" status to the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services in 1957
- As a State Apprenticeship Agency Ohio has the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council which advises the Agency on the Registered Apprenticeship system of Ohio.
- In 2016 ODJFS branded ApprenticeOhio





#### **ApprenticeOhio**

- ApprenticeOhio registers and monitors apprenticeship programs to ensure quality and safety
  - Registered Apprenticeship Programs
  - Recognized Pre-Apprenticeship Programs



#### Registered Apprenticeship

- Industry driven, high quality career pathway
- Employers develop and prepare their future workforce.
- Individuals obtain
  - paid work experience
  - classroom instruction
  - mentorship
  - nationally recognized credential



### Register Apprenticeship Sponsor Requirements





#### Registered Apprenticeship

Once approved, an organization operating a Registered Apprenticeship program is considered a Sponsor. Sponsor's include community organizations, learning institutions, employers and unions.







#### Recognized Pre-Apprenticeship

- Teaches basic technical and job-readiness skills
- Based on occupational sector
- Forms a pipeline of talent to Registered Apprenticeship
- Must have a linkage with a Registered Apprenticeship sponsor
- Eligible for up to 12 points toward graduation requirements

Pre-Apprenticeship normally features a classroom and/or lab setting, but may also involve work-site visits, job shadowing, or other work experience outside to provide exposure to the work environment for the targeted occupation(s) and industry.






#### Apprenticeship Hubs



#### Hubs Structure & Program Development


