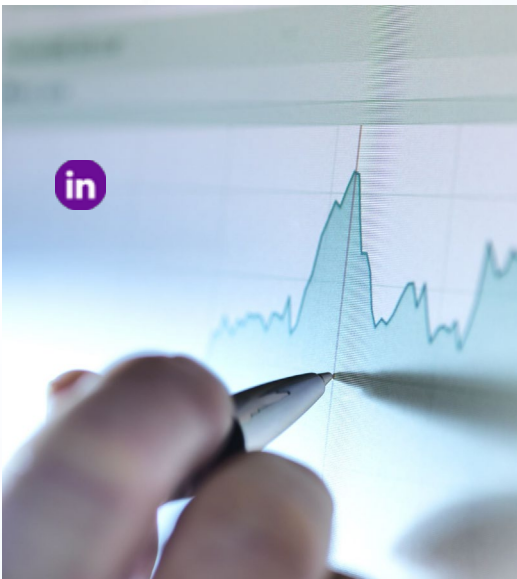

**In-Demand Jobs Week Event Map -**



- Students will be expected to perform job duties similar to what would be expected in an entry-level position.



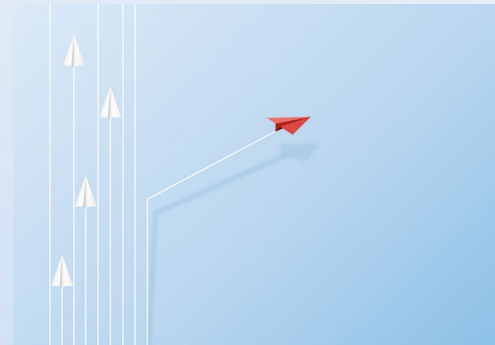
