Governing Board Members' Update

Delaware Area Career Center

Mr. Bischoff reported that students in the Culinary Arts program provided an excellent meal for Board members at the last meeting. DACC Board members also discussed the loophole in the recent approved Ohio law that now allows Townships in Ohio to decide which school districts their students can attend if the Township is located in more than one school district. This could have a significant impact on small local districts.

Dr. Goodney informed Board members that Mayor Ginther recently held a meeting at the ESCCO with Franklin County Superintendents who have students residing in the City of Columbus. In addition to discussing issues and concerns, the Mayor also discussed his Birth to Age 5 initiatives.
