24.04.02 APPROVED TRANSFER OF PROPERTY

It was moved by Ms. Kish and seconded by Mrs. Galbraith the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio Governing Board approve the following resolution to transfer property from the Buckeye Valley Local School District to the Olentangy Local School District.

WHEREAS, Section 3311.22 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the transfer of school district territory from one local school district to another local school district within the territory of an educational service center; and

WHEREAS, the territory of the Buckeye Valley Local School District ("BVLSD") and the territory of the Olentangy Local School District ("OLSD") are both located within the territory of the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio; and

WHEREAS, certain real property, as more fully described below, is currently located within the territory of the BVLSD; and

WHEREAS, said real property adjoins the OLSD; and

WHEREAS, said real property was purchased by the OLSD in December 2023; and

WHEREAS, prior to today, the Superintendent of the ESC of Central Ohio has confirmed with both school districts that they are in agreement to transfer said property from the BVLSD to the OLSD; and

WHEREAS, this Board at its meeting held on March 22, 2024 adopted a Resolution proposing the transfer of the subject property from the BVLSD to the OLSD, pursuant to R.C. § 3311.22; and

WHEREAS, following the adoption of said Resolution, the Treasurer filed a copy of that Resolution, together with an accurate map of the territory described in the Resolution, with the boards of education of the BVLSD, OLSD, and the Delaware City School District; and

WHEREAS, at least thirty days have passed since the adoption of that Resolution proposing the transfer of said territory; and

WHEREAS, no qualified electors residing in the area proposed to be transferred, equal in number to a majority of the qualified electors voting at the last general election, filed a petition of referendum against such transfer at the office of the Superintendent of this Board within thirty days of the adoption of the Resolution proposing the transfer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, in accordance with Section 3311.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, that the Governing Board of the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio hereby transfers the following described property from the Buckeye Valley Local School District to the Olentangy Local School District effective on June 30, 2024:

Approximately 89.93 acres located at Buntz Station Road in Delaware County, Ohio, known as Delaware County Parcel Numbers: 419-2400-1020-000, 419-2400-1019-000, 419-2400-1017-000, 419-2400-1016-000, and 419-2400-1015-000.

The update included information regarding upcoming ESSER sustainability workshops sponsored by Project Evident, OESA and the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce. Dr. Goodney also discussed the role the ESC of Central Ohio could have to assist our client school districts with these efforts. The update also included the State Board of Education's budget shortfall that may result in an increase in licensure fees and HB 250 that would require public schools to adopt a policy governing the use of cell phones by students during school hours.
