**Executive Director Update:** ESCCO Deputy Superintendent Gale Marsh updated the Governing Board on the following:

The ESC Council of Governments with the Governing Board action today now employs 3,245 Substitutes which is the

highest number we have employed in years.

o We believe that districts in the post ESSER Funds are shifting and moving staff employed by the ESC COG Governing Board

by cutting back in other ares. Thus, we have not seen the reductions in staff we were anticipating might occur.

o London City Schools voted in November and Jonathan Alder Local Schools voted in December to align with the ESC of Central

Ohio effective July 1, 2025. Boards of Education are permitted by December 31of even years to align with a different ESC for

the fiscal year commencing the following July. We were prepared for London City Schools based on prior conversations but

were surprised by the decision by Jonathan Alder Schools. We look forward to working with both schools to meet their

educational program needs.

Treasurer Update: ESC COG Director of Finance Tammy Rizzo mentioned that the financial audit for FY24 was underway and the

audit should be released in early Spring, 2025. Ms. Rizzo also apologized for not having the November, 2024 financial

statements prepared in time for the meeting.
