<b>Newsela</b>	Digital Library	Newsela offers a library of high-interest, cross-curricular, adjustable non-fiction texts. Each of the articles are written at five different Lexile levels.	Free Through end of 2019-20 school year
<b>Flipgrid</b>	Video Discussion Tool	Flipgrid is a social learning platform that allows educators to ask a question, then the students respond in a video. Students are then able to respond to one another, creating a “web” of discussion.	Free
<b>TweenTribune</b>	Digital Library	Offered by the Smithsonian for use by K-12 students and teachers, TweenTribune provides a collection of news articles at four different Lexile levels.	Free
<b>Screencastify</b>	Screen Recording Tool	Screencastify is a simple screen-recording tool. It can be used to record, edit, and share videos. Screencastify is a browser extension for Google Chrome.	Free
