

## **Emergency Removal Form**

Emergency removal procedures are initiated when it is determined that the special class student's continued presence poses an immediate danger to persons or property or is disruptive to the educational process. The parent or custodian of the student must be notified immediately of such removal. Emergency removal cannot exceed 24 hours.

According to the Ohio Revised Code (3313.66(c)), the superintendent, or a principal, or assistant principal may remove a pupil from curricular or extracurricular activities or from the school premises. No hearing is required unless suspension or expulsion is contemplated.
