E. Federal Compliance System

ESSA and IDEA compliance review criteria for a Desk Review, Onsite Review, or Self Survey criteria. Indication of completion is provided by the district. Districts will be notified by approximately November, if the Office of Federal The Office of Federal Programs in the Ohio Dept. of Education will notify districts if they have been selected for an Onsite or Desk Review of their Federal Program initiatives. This review includes both program and fiscal documentation as designated in the Compliance survey. If the district is selected for an Onsite or Desk Review required documents are to be loaded into the compliance system for preview.
