To begin the SY 23, you may consider sharing the Federal Programs <u>Public</u> (ignore the FY 21-this list remains the same annually) and <u>Nonpublic Building</u> Review Worksheet with building leadership. These docs include all building-level federal requirements should the building receive federal grant funding support.

District Federal Personnel Documentation:

<u>Federally Funded Personnel Spreadsheet</u> – Update periodically with Fund Code payroll reports (Title I Fund 571, Title II Fund 571, Title II Fund 551, Title IV Fund 584, Title V-B Rural Fund 599 & Expanding Opportunities Fund 572)

<u>Time and Effort</u> Form – utilized for those not working full-time with one responsibility/role

Semi-Annual <u>Single Funding Source Certification</u> (signed to verify allowable grant service after service is provided in January and June) – A part of the Treasurer record keeping

Note: If applicable, **create contract(s) for equitable nonpublic services** appropriated for Title I, II-A, III-A, IV-A, and/or IDEA-Part B — Special Education at the beginning of the year to obligate NP service amounts. Verify the qualifying student enrollment has not changed since the Nonpublic Data System data was entered and validate student addresses to align with your district's attendance area.

District/Building Parent Involvement Documentation:

As we discussed district and building web sites are the best to share publicly your <u>district parent</u> <u>involvement policy</u>, <u>building parent involvement plans</u>, <u>Parent Right-to-Know</u> notification, <u>Building Compacts</u> for Title I served buildings. Title I buildings are required to share Title I information with their parents/community-Meeting Guide and Sample Agenda.-Fall meeting is recommended.

<u>Sample Parent Letter</u> information – for English Learner Identification – required 30 Day Letter if students start the school year or two weeks if students begin the school year at a different time.
