Position Title: Intervention Specialist

Reports To: Principals

Summary Statement:

The Intervention Specialist is responsible for working in conjunction with the DCS administration to aid students that require intervention while promoting the mission and vision of DCS.

Duties:

- Work with classroom teachers to determine the level of intervention needed for a student
- Aid classroom teachers in providing intervention within the normal curriculum
- Pull students from normal classroom instruction when needed
- Collaborate with Delaware City to hold parent meetings for new and re-evaluation of plans
- Create and manage the schedule of intervention with teachers
- Manage the Jon Peterson Scholarship with the Ohio Department of Education
- Assist in the administration of the ACT National Test with students needing accommodations
- Assist in the administration of the Standardized Testing with students needing accommodations
- Assist in the administration of the End of the Course Exams with students needing accommodations
