Governing Board Members' Update

Eastland-Fairfield Career & Technical Schools

Mrs. Galbraith reported that the EFCTS Board meet on Wednesday. New EFCTS Superintendent, Dr. Kim Pietsch Miller, updated Board members on school attendance issues related to the pandemic and building construction progress. The EFCTS Treasurer reported on funds received from pandemic related grants.

Delaware Area Career Center

Mr. Bischoff reported that the DACC met by phone this week for a short business meeting. Cheryl Ryan, OSBA?, was in attendance to update Board members on their Superintendent search and distribute a schedule. The goal is to select a new Superintendent this Spring while school is open and before MaryBeth Freeman retires.

Governing Board Vacancy

Mr. Spencer reported that one person responded to the vacancy posted, Ms. Charm London. Following a review of Ms. London's resume by ESCCO Board members and meetings with Mr. Spencer, Dr. Goodney and Mr. Varda, it was determined that the candidate is certainly qualified to fill the position and will bring a wealth of experience and knowledge to the Governing Board. All Board members concurred to have Mr. Spencer contact Ms. London to inform her she will be appointed at the January 15, 2021 organizational meeting.

Treasurer's Update

Mr. Varda informed Board members that the State of Ohio Auditor's office will be closed the last 2 weeks of December resulting in a delay of auditing the ESCCO and the ESCCO COG until after January 1, 2021. The ESCCO's accounting firm, Julian & Grube, Inc., requested that the ESCCO request from the Auditor of State an extension till the December 31, 2020 deadline for filing the ESCCO's annual GAAP financial statements.

Mr. Varda commended David Weaver, Assistant Treasurer, on preparing for the Internal Revenue Service's audit of the ESCCO COG. IRS representatives were very complimentary and very impressed with the organization of records for the audit.

Mr. Varda reported that the benefits open enrollment has been completed and payroll staff is currently uploading information before the December payroll dates.

regarding the portion of the bill on ESC funding and the need for ESC's to have a predictable and stable funding model.

Dr. Goodney informed Board members of his decision to return Central Office staff to working full-time at home through January 15, 2021. Essential staff will continue to come in to perform necessary work.

As client school districts are shifting back to remote learning, Dr. Goodney informed Board members that this is partially due to the insufficient availability of substitute teachers.
