RBT vs. Specialized BT

- RBT®: complete 40 hours of coursework related to an official Task List of relevant skills, must pass a Competency Assessment, must pass a written exam, and practice under the ongoing supervision of a BCBA.
- RBT® Task List: 37 individual skills
- Specialized Behavior Technician Program: micro-credentialing in 10 individual skills most relevant to supporting students within a school environment.





RBT CERTIFICATION PATHWAY





RBT

- Curriculum: The Happy Medium
 - The Happy Medium RBT (eclipsetherapy.com)
 - Focus on neurodiversity, trauma informed lens, student preference
 - 40 hours of self-paced online training
- Touchpoints with BCBA (ESC or district BCBA)
- Certification
 - Competency Assessment (conducted by BCBA)
 - Must be in person
 - Exam (fee for exam)
 - Supervision & Ongoing Credentialing



District Understandings – RBT

- Max 2 participants per cycle (first cycle beginning Nov. 1, 2022)
- Need 45 hours minimum sub time allotment (curriculum completion + touchpoint meetings)
- District or individual responsible for application & exam fees
- District responsible for creating and maintaining supervision plan once exam has been passed
 - 5% of monthly hours must be supervised by BCBA
 - RBT must follow ethics code (may need consent)
 - Credential renewal (yearly)



RBT Supervision by ESC BCBA

Limited - based on availability of ESC staff

 District must provide consent forms for any students observed as part of ESC BCBA supervision

Specialized BT Program

- Canvas modules with PowerPoints, videos, readings, assessment questions and reflection activities
 - Can complete all or select based on need
 - Rolling enrollment beginning Nov. 1, 2022
 - Module 1 prerequisite to all additional modules
- Embedded touchpoint meetings with ESC BCBAs or lead within district
- GOAL: Districts provide an in-house lead OR in-house lead is developed by completing all modules and working with ESC team

- 6. C-12: Implement Token Economy Procedures
- 7. D-2: Describe Common Functions of Behavior
- 8. D-4: Implement Differential Reinforcement Procedures
- 9. D-5: Implement Extinction Procedures/Alternatives to Extinction Procedures
- 10.F-4/F-5: Maintain Professional Boundaries / Maintain Client Dignity
