

## **Private Provider Plan**

To the extent consistent with Administrative Guideline 6320d, this constitutes the private provider plan. This plan will begin on \_\_\_\_\_\_ and end on \_\_\_\_\_\_. This time period shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_\_ hours of direct service and \_\_\_\_\_\_ hours of consultation and/or collaboration meeting time with school personnel per week. Availability of school personnel will be determined by **the Educational Service Center**. In addition, this plan shall not exceed one school year, \_\_\_\_\_\_ (date) but includes the option to phase out private provider services as mutually agreed upon by school personnel and parents, and also includes the option of termination by the Superintendent, pursuant to Administrative Guideline 6320d. Direct service is defined as observation of student participating in classroom setting and/or assisting student as agreed upon by ESCCO personnel. If private provider is absent, the following guidelines will be followed:

- 1. Parent will notify classroom teacher
- 2. Parent will schedule make-up days with ESCCO personnel.
- 3. A substitute private provider will not be provided by ESCCO.
- 4. A substitute provider will not be provided by parents without prior consent of ESCCO.
