- Ability to rapidly adapt to changing web technologies and quickly adopt new systems and approaches

Responsibilities and Essential Functions:

- Builds, updates, and maintains a wide variety of custom-built web applications
- Works on OCALI web development projects include e-learning systems, content management systems, and survey and assessment systems.
- Collaborates on projects and their progress with the web development team
- Provides supervision of web development team
- Demonstrates accuracy, responsiveness and excellent communications with other members of the web development team and related staff
- Completes other duties as assigned by the Senior Director, Integrated Solutions and Project management
- In addition, performs other specific job-related duties as directed by the Superintendent or his/her designee
