Comments: Charles ended the year with an FTE of 290.8. The Charles School is on-track financially and meeting their obligations. Enrollment remains consistent and close to projections. The fiscal reports show the school has revenue in excess of expenditures for the last month of the school year. The balance needs to be higher to maintain financial stability.

Comments: The school is currently in Priority Status due to the Graduation Rate based on the 2018-2019 state report card. The school provides opportunities for students while taking college classes at ODU. The state measures success first with a four-year graduation rate followed by a five-year graduation rate. The Charles School is meeting standards in progress, approaching standards in achievement and gap closing, and working towards standards in graduation (due to graduation rate being based on 4-year and not 5-year rates.) The school exceeded their mission specific goals for multiple years at the beginning of the contract. They have since updated their mission specific goals and are exceeding in their English Language Arts and Math goals and working to achieve their SEL (Social Emotional Learning) goal. Performance ratings over multiple years can be found in the attached performance framework. They are consistently approaching the standard in achievement. Student achievement is varied depending on the content area with social studies, science, and ELA being higher than math. The school is supporting all students-those following a traditional path towards graduation and those interested in college coursework while in high school.

7. Conclusion

How is the school performing in relation to the contractual requirements?

Comments:

Areas of Strength: The Charles School has continued to be consistent in their implementation of a well-balanced curriculum which includes both required state standards coupled with identified habits of learning. The school's leadership has been intentional and focused on building culture while keeping a focus on student and staff well-being. The partnership with Ohio Dominican University, which allows students who qualify to attend the university to earn college credits while still in high school, continues to grow with significant numbers of students who are currently enrolled in the program, with additional students eligible to join. The school is supporting students with options including coursework at Ohio Dominican University, coursework at Columbus State Community College through CCP and coursework leading to

industry credentials in the school building through CTE. The school's commitment to providing opportunities to students is to be commended. Charles is set to receive high quality school funds for their results on the Ohio Report Card.

Areas of Improvement: The Charles School needs to continue their work in improving student achievement and growth on standardized assessment. Data is showing improvement, and it will be necessary for all staff to continue the progress in these areas.

Subsequent Actions: The school will continue to review both growth and achievement data and monitor adult implementation towards goal progress quarterly.

Summary of Performance Over Contract Term and Prospects for Renewal: The Charles School at Ohio Dominican University's contract is set to expire June 30, 2024. They are on track for successful renewal as long as all processes are successfully completed and continued in the manner that they have been over the past year. A High Stakes Review will occur in December of the 2023-2024 school year.
